Minimum Wage Increase – 2015

It has been announced by the Provincial Government that the minimum wage (Ontario) will be increased from the 1st October 2015, as indicated below. This will allow each Centre to prepare their payroll records accordingly. Should you require any additional information, please refer to the Ministry of Labour web site at www.labour.gov.on.ca.
